Appointment of Chair

Voting on BOM positions

President and Treasurer's reports

The president Jason Clouston gave a short report in which he urged more participation from members in the day-to-day work of the federation and stressed that the federation is our federation and we all have to put in effort for it to work.

The Treasurer Martin Kiosew gave a presentation on the state of the federation's finances and asked for people to try to pay fees on time rather than waiting until a grading or seminar is approaching.

Disciplinary Procedure

No agreement was reached on the implementation of a disciplinary procedure. This will be revisited at a later date.

Coaching manual

It was agreed that the adoption of a coaching manual should not be rushed into and that a draft version would be created for discussion based on existing initial draft produced by Vincent Long. Dojo leaders will be asked for input and existing documents will be consulted. It was also suggested that any proposed document should be reviewed by a sensei before being adopted.

Definitions of BOM roles

Patrick McGuire, Jason Buckley, Aaron, Michal Walz volunteered to work on definitions of roles for the BOM positions.

Amendments to constitution

It was agreed to leave the requirement for judges for the Nationals as is in the constitution for now.

Membership Fees, Finances & Fundraising

There was some discussion on how to improve the financial position of the federation.

It was suggested that the BOM should update the membership more regularly on finances and encourage clubs to organise fundraising events.

Suggestions for how to restructure the federation fees were also made, including enforcing membership at a certain grade, or a deposit for beginners. It was agreed that Martin would contact the dojo leaders and aim to come back with a proposed fee structure.

AJKF Bogu Donation

It was agreed that a \leq 150 deposit would be charged for the new sets of bogu from the AJKF donation. A reduced rate (\leq 100 was suggested) would be applied to used sets. Other equipment was distributed to the smaller clubs.
